

# Future with will

The **future simple** with "**will**" is used to talk about actions or events that will happen **after now**. It's one of the most common ways to express the future in English.

	Structure	Example	Uses of will
Affirmative	Subject + <b>will</b> + base verb	I <b>will study</b> medicine.	<b>Uses of "Will"</b> <b>1. Decisions made at the moment of speaking</b> – I'm tired. I <b>will go</b> to bed. – I don't know. Maybe I <b>will study</b> architecture. <b>2. Predictions about the future</b> – I think she <b>will be</b> a great lawyer. – It <b>will rain</b> tomorrow. <b>3. Promises or offers</b> – Don't worry, I <b>will help</b> you choose a career. – I <b>will write</b> you a recommendation letter. <b>4. Facts or certainty in the future</b> – The semester <b>will start</b> in March. – You <b>will need</b> good grades to apply.
Negative	Subject + <b>will not (won't)</b> + verb	He <b>won't attend</b> the class.	
Yes/No Q	<b>Will</b> + subject + verb?	<b>Will</b> you go to university?	
Short Ans.	Yes, + subject + <b>will</b> / No, + subject + <b>won't</b>	Yes, I will. / No, she won't.
