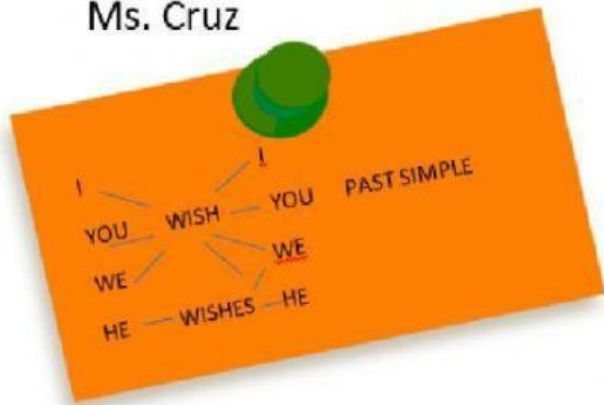
Real situation

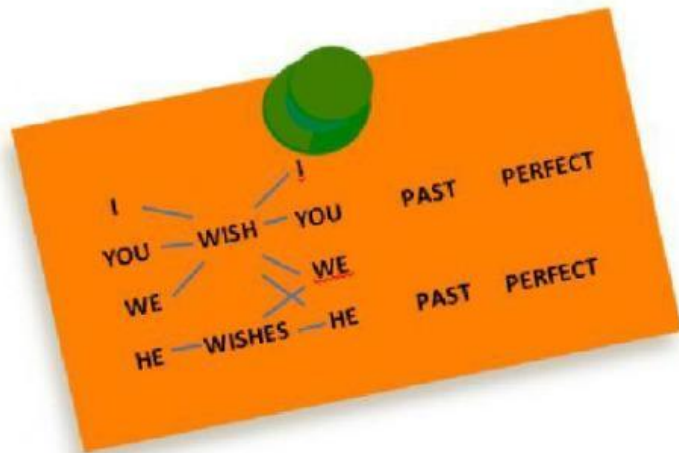

Raul **wishes** he **hadn't bought** that car.



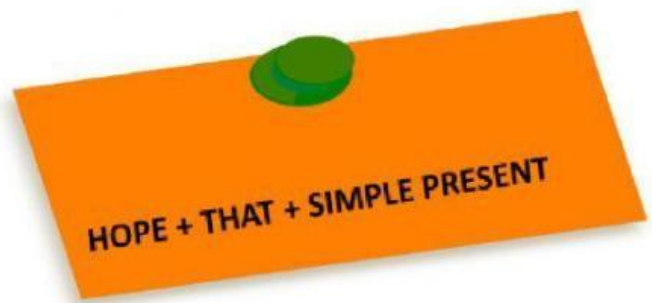
