


Ancient Egyptian life and art

We already know that cats were important to the Ancient Egyptians, but what else can we learn about their daily life from their art?

c Men and women had different jobs. Men usually worked outside, while women worked indoors at home. In paintings, women often have paler skin than men, to show this difference.

Although most people wore very plain, simple clothes, Egyptian art often shows kings and queens wearing long, bright white clothes. This shows how important they were.

Bread was one of the most important foods in Ancient Egypt, and everyone ate a lot of it. They also ate lots of vegetables and fish. Many sculptures and paintings show people making bread.

In Ancient Egypt, doctors were thought to be the best in the whole world. There are paintings on papyrus of doctors treating patients.


