Central Park is an urban park between the Upper West Side and Upper East Side neighborhoods of Manhattan, in New York City. It is the sixth-largest park in the city and the most visited urban park in the United States.

Central Park is 2.5 miles (4 km) long, and 0.5 miles (0.8 km) wide.

There are different places to rent a bike but you can also ride your own bike. You can visit famous places from films. You will have a great experience because you can see some concerts around the park.


BOW BRIDGE
