

PRACTICE: Parts of Speech - Adjectives, Nouns, and Verbs

Parts of Speech are categories that words fall into based on their function in a sentence. Today, we will focus on three parts of speech:

1. **Adjective:** A word that describes or modifies a noun. Example: *beautiful, tall, happy*.
2. **Noun:** A word that names a person, place, thing, or idea. Example: *dog, school, happiness*.
3. **Verb:** A word that describes an action or a state. Example: *run, eat, think*.

Now, read the following sentences and identify the part of speech of the word in **bold**.
