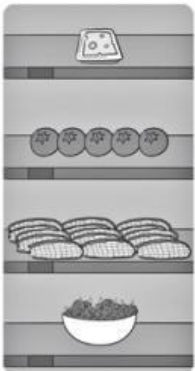


Quantifiers with countable and uncountable nouns

Countable	There are a few / some / a lot of seeds.	There aren't any eggs.
Uncountable	There's a little / some / a lot of bread.	There isn't any sugar.

We can't count uncountable nouns:
bread, water
