

# Clauses of Result

Clauses of Result are introduced by:

- that (after such\so) (and) as a result, (and) as a consequence, consequently, so, etc. It was such bad weather that we stayed in. He was ill as a result he didn't go to work.
- **such a \ an+ (adjective) + singular countable noun.** He is such a rude person, that nobody likes him.
- **such + (adjective) + uncountable\ plural noun.** It was such lovely scenery that we took lots of photos.
- **such + a lot of + noun** There were such a lot of people on the train that we couldn't get on.
- **so+adjective\adverb** She drives so careless that she's bound to have an accident.
- **so+ few\little\many\much + noun** He had so much luggage that he couldn't carry it.
- **so+ adjective+a\an + noun** It's so hot a day that everyone is going to the beach.
- **as a result\therefore\consequently\so+ clause.** The cinema was crowded so we left.

### **SO + прикметник/прислівник**

**SO** вживається з прикметниками або прислівниками, щоб підкреслити ступінь якості (дуже, такий).

структура:

#### **so + adjective/adverb**

Приклади:

She is so beautiful. – Вона така красива.

He runs so fast. – Він бігає так швидко.

It's so cold today. – Сьогодні так холодно.

### **SUCH + іменник (іноді з прикметником)**

**SUCH** використовується з іменниками, щоб описати щось або когось (такий, така, таке, такі).

структура:

#### **such + (adjective) + noun**

Приклади:

It was such fun! – Це було так весело!

They are such nice people. – Вони такі хороші люди.

That's such nonsense! – Це така нісенітниця!

### **SUCH A/AN + прикметник + однина іменника**

Вживається тоді, коли іменник у однині і злічуваний.

Перед ним стоїть **a** або **an**

структура:

#### **such a/an + adjective + singular countable noun**


Приклади:

It was such a good idea. – Це була така гарна ідея.

He is such an intelligent boy. – Він такий розумний хлопець.

She's such a nice teacher. – Вона така хороша вчителька.
