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IMPERATIVE SENTENCES

The imperative is used to **give orders and instructions**, or to **give an advice to someone**. For example:

Orders: *Make your bed!*

Instructions: *Read the text!*

Advice: *Be careful!*



Do not forget to use bare infinitives (base form) when building an imperative sentence.

Affirmative

Bare infinitive

~~to~~ make – **Make** your bed!

Negative

Don't + bare infinitive

Don't make so much noise!
