| POSITIVE | EXAMPLE |
|---|-------------------------------------|
| I + verb → don't change | I get up at eight o'clock. |
| He/She + verb → CHANGE → Add -S -ES -IES | He goes to school at seven o'clock. |

| NEGATIVE | EXAMPLE |
|---|---|
| I + don't + verb | I don't get up at eight o'clock |
| He/She + doesn't + verb Verb doesn't change | He doesn't go to school at seven o'clock. |

| QUESTION | EXAMPLE |
|---------------------------|--|
| Do + I + verb ...? | Do I get up at eight o'clock? |
| Yes, I do. | Yes, I do. |
| No, I don't. | No, I don't. |
| Does + he/she + verb ...? | Does he go to school at seven o'clock? |
| Yes, he/she does. | Yes, he does. |
| No, he/she doesn't. | No, he doesn't. |
