Two thirds of the UK population were classified as overweight or obese in 2015.	
Diet control would be the more important factor in controlling weight gain.	
In France, foods containing a certain amount of sugar are taxed a set amount of money per litre or gram.	
France imposed a tax on drinks containing added sugar or sweetener, at 7.55 cents per litre.	
Taxes on sugar-sweetened beverages started in 1933.
