

STRING INSTRUMENTS

PLUCKED STRING INSTRUMENTS (CUERDA PULSADA)

The sound is produced by plucking the strings with our fingers or a plectrum. (Pulsamos con los dedos o con una púa).

BOWED STRING INSTRUMENTS (CUERDA FROTADA)

The player pulls a rosined horsehair bow across the strings, causing them to vibrate. (La cuerda se frota con un arco con resina).

STRUCK STRING INSTRUMENTS (CUERDA PERCUTIDA)

The sound is produced by the string being struck with a mallet or hammer. (La cuerda es percutida con un martillo o maza).
