## Sheku Kanneh-Mason

Sheku Kanneh-Mason was born in Nottingham, England, in 1999. He has an interesting background because his father is from the Caribbean while his mother is from West Africa. He started playing the violin when he was five but soon changed to the cello. He became famous in 2016 when he won the prestigious competition, *Young Musician of the Year*. He was the first black musician to receive this award.

Sheku has played twice at the BAFTA Film Awards, the British equivalent of the Oscars. In addition, millions of people around the world saw him when he played at the wedding of Prince Harry and Meghan Markle in 2018. In the same year his first album came out. It was an enormous success and millions of people have listened to it online.

Sheku is a big fan of reggae as well as of classical music and has performed versions of some famous reggae songs on the cello. He has also performed together with his sister, Isata, a pianist, and his brother, Braimah, a violinist. It's a very musical family! Sheku Kanneh-Mason is an artist of great skill and creativity.
