Borisov

A. ___ Borisov is one of the most ancient and wonderful towns in Belarus. It is situated in a very picturesque place. The landscape in this part of the Republic is exceptionally beautiful. There are rivers, lakes and forests full of different plants, berries and mushrooms. It has a rather long history in comparison with some other towns. Many years have passed since 1102, when the Grand Duke of Polotsk Boris Vseslavovich built a small wooden fortress on the left bank of the Berezina river, then an important trade route. The settlement got its name after its founder and this name has never been changed. That was “the beginning” of Borisov.

B. ___ At that time Borisov was not only a trade but military settlement as well. It had to resist the attacks of many foreign invaders and Borisov witnessed many wars. In 1812 the French army was destroyed not far from the town. There was a great battle near the village of Studyonka where Napoleon lost more than

30000 soldiers. There is The Victory Memorial in honour of the victory of the Russian troops over the French.

C. Obviously there are a lot of sights related to the Great Patriotic War. In Revolution Avenue people can visit a monument to Lyusya Chalovskaya. She was a brave girl who often brought important information for partisans in the years of the Great Patriotic War.

D. In Chapaev street there is a monument to the Victims of Fascism. The Eternal Flame is burning here day and night reminding the town people about those who were killed during the war in concentration camps. It orders us not to forget the sufferings of our people during the war. On a high bank of the Berezina river one can see a tank. It's a monument to the tank crew of Pavel Rack who was the first to rush into the town in 1944.

E. The pride of our town is the Local Museum. It was founded in 1950 and it is situated on the very hill from which, according to the legend, Prince Boris observed the surroundings. There are six halls in the museum. Each of them is connected with a certain period of our history. The museum has a lot of exhibits, which tell the visitors about the past, present and even future of Borisov.

F. Speaking about the most popular places of the town, we should mention about the stadium Borisov-Arena where the citizens of the town often go. They can watch football matches, different sport competitions and festivals. Borisov is a lovely place and you are hospitably welcomed here.
