



Future Continuous




Rule: WILL + _____ + VERB – ING

A completed action by a future point of reference.




Rule: WILL + _____ + VERB – 3rd form

e.g.: By the year 2030, I will have _____.

Future Perfect Continuous

An action in progress for some time by a future point of reference



Rule: WILL + HAVE + _____ + VERB – ING

e.g.: By the year 2026, I will have been _____ for _____ years.
