Today, many countries are using more renewable energy to protect the Earth. We should try to save energy and use clean sources to make our planet greener.

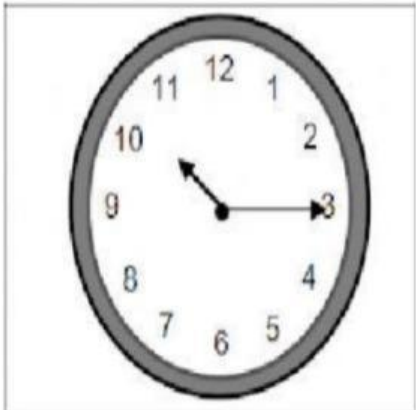
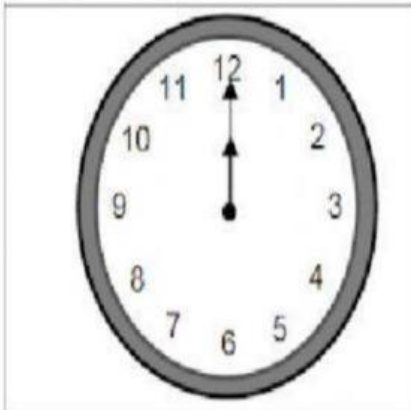
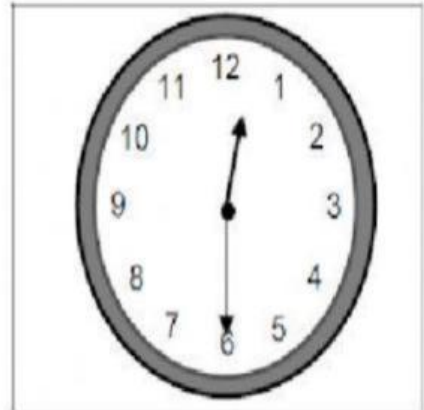
