	All Spartan citizens were full-time soldiers and spent their lives training for battle.
	Confrontation between Athens and Sparta.
	They wrote laws and prepared policies which were debated in the assembly.
	Group of cities under Athens' control.
	Politician that strengthened democracy and promoted culture and art in the city of Athens.
	System of government in Sparta in which there were two kings from the aristocracy in power.
	They enforced the laws made by the Council of 500.
