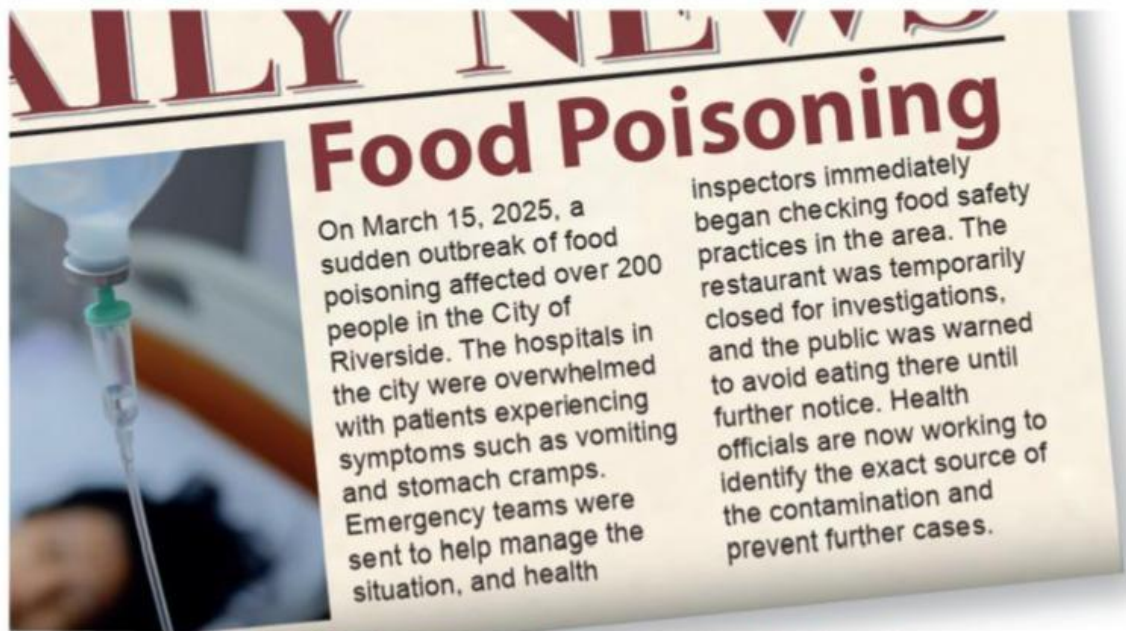

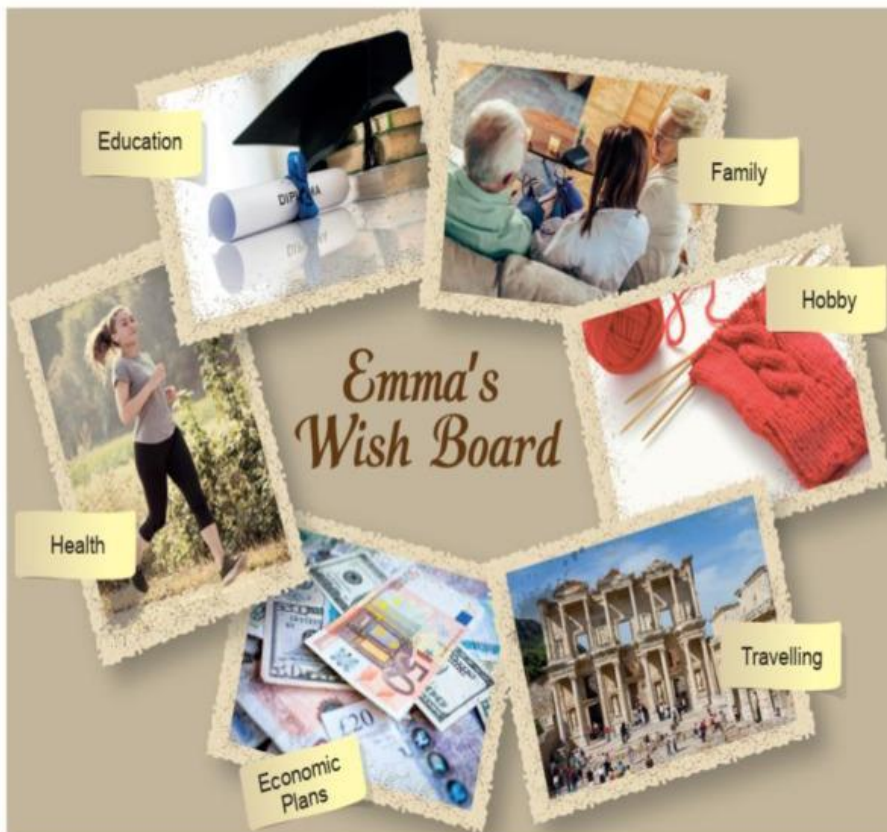
Read the following news about a recent health issue and summarize it in four sentences at most, including its main points.
