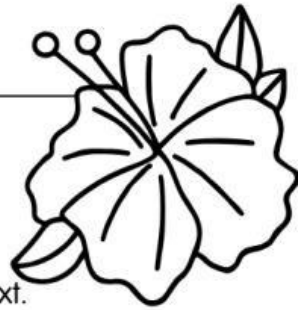

The Javan Rhino (*Rhinoceros sondaicus*) is one of the rarest large mammals in the world. It is found only in Ujung Kulon National Park in Indonesia. This species is known for its single horn, thick grey skin, and armor-like folds. The Javan Rhino is solitary and shy, living in dense tropical rainforests and muddy lowlands.

These rhinos have excellent hearing and a strong sense of smell but relatively poor eyesight. They prefer areas with water and thick vegetation, which provide food and cover. They often wallow in mud to cool their bodies and protect their skin from parasites.

Javan Rhinos are herbivores. They feed on leaves, shoots, fruits, and twigs. They are most active in the early morning or late afternoon and require large home ranges to find enough food and stay undisturbed.

This species is critically endangered due to habitat destruction, low birth rates, and the risk of natural disasters. Conservationists monitor their population using camera traps and patrol their habitat to prevent human interference. Protecting the Javan Rhino is vital to preserving Indonesia's biodiversity.
