Online shopping is fast and fantastic, says Sheila Volmer

Only three or four years ago many people didn't want to shop online: 'Online shopping is frightening and full of problems: you can lose your money, you can't see the thing that you are buying and someone can steal your credit card information! '

Nowadays millions of us buy things on the internet. Go on. Try it. It's so easy. You can save money and time. And do you hate crowds? Do you really want to spend all Saturday morning at your local shopping centre looking for a present for your grandfather or a special CD? Well with online shopping you can sit at home and relax at the same time as ordering clothes, electrical goods, books, DVDs etc. Think of all the money you pay for driving to the shops and parking or for taking the train or bus.

So what is stopping you? Many people are frightened about security. Don't be! All the big online shops and internet websites have got excellent security. I think it's better than in ordinary shops. I have shopped online for over five years now. I've bought a DVD player, a new computer, lots of books and DVDs. And now I use the internet to order my shopping and the supermarket sends it direct to my house every two weeks. I've never had any problems and now I have a lot of extra free time to enjoy reading and watching those DVDs.

So where can you start? Try something small such as a book or CD. Amazon.co.uk is a very good place to start. Everything is cheaper than in shops and it usually takes only four or five days for delivery. The longest time I have waited was two weeks around Christmas time when they were very busy. When you feel comfortable with this you could try other websites and goods. One day you might even want to start selling things yourself and then you can try a website such as Ebay.
