

## Simple present x Present progressive

**Present progressive:**

 - Use for actions that are happening **NOW**.

STATEMENTS	YES-NO QUESTIONS	SHORT ANSWERS	
I <b>am</b> (not) <b>working</b> .	<b>Am</b> I <b>working</b> ?	Yes, I <b>am</b> .	No, I <b>am not</b> .
You <b>are</b> (not) <b>working</b> .	<b>Are</b> you <b>working</b> ?	Yes, you <b>are</b> .	No, you <b>are not</b> .
He <b>is</b> (not) <b>working</b> .	<b>Is</b> he <b>working</b> ?	Yes, he <b>is</b> .	No, he <b>is not</b> .
She <b>is</b> (not) <b>working</b> .	<b>Is</b> she <b>working</b> ?	Yes, she <b>is</b> .	No, she <b>is not</b> .
It <b>is</b> (not) <b>working</b> .	<b>Is</b> it <b>working</b> ?	Yes, it <b>is</b> .	No, it <b>is not</b> .
We <b>are</b> (not) <b>working</b> .	<b>Are</b> we <b>working</b> ?	Yes, we <b>are</b> .	No, we <b>are not</b> .
They <b>are</b> (not) <b>working</b> .	<b>Are</b> they <b>working</b> ?	Yes, they <b>are</b> .	No, they <b>are not</b> .
