Oprah Winfrey a success story



Oprah Winfrey is internationally famous for hosting the most popular talk show on American television. Millions of TV viewers used to watch her every day. She is now one of the richest women in the world. She is also famous for raising millions of dollars for charities to help with child literacy.

Oprah was born in 1954 in Mississippi. She was born to a single teenage mother and live their first years with her grandmother at such poverty she had to wear with potato sacks of dresses. When Oprah was 6 years old her grandmother became ill so she moved to live with her mother. At age 9 she was raped by her 19-year-old cousin. If she had stayed living with her grandmother, she wouldn't have experienced child abuse as she grew up. All of this experiences led her to campaign for children's rights later in her life. She helped draft a bill that President Clinton passed into law.

At age 14 she moved to live with her father at Nashville Tennessee and there her life's turnaround. She became interested in media and when she was 19 she pursued a career in television. Her career in broadcasting started in 1971 and her big opportunity came in 1976 with her own extremely popular TV chat show – 'People Are Talking', she was the first black female news anchor before the age of 20. Despite that she was sexually harassed work and few months later she was fired because the producer said she was unfit for television news, she started hosting the morning talk show in Chicago and turned it to the highest-rated talk show in Chicago it was later renamed "Oprah Winfrey show".

In 1985 movie producer Steven Spielberg offered her a role in 'The Color Purple'. She was nominated for an Oscar at the Academy Awards for her performance. If she hadn't been nominated, maybe she would have never become as famous and influential as she is now. This opened all kinds of doors for her she had never dreamed of. Her chat show is broadcast to over 100 countries. 'Life' magazine called her the most influential woman of her generation. She succeeded and she is now one of the 400 richest people in America inspiring millions of people and constantly helped in the community. She has raised nearly \$100 million for charity. She is now a role model for millions of girls around the world. Her latest project is an academy for poor girls, which opened in South Africa.

She is a great woman who encourages others to fight for their dreams, motivating them with her phrases and her life on how to overcome adversity and fulfill dreams despite how impossible it may seem.
