ON

- **Days** (on Monday, on Thursday, on Sunday)

- **Day+ part of day** (on Sunday morning (s) on Friday afternoon (s))
- **Dates** (on April 3rd, on the 8th, on the first day)
- **Specific day** (on my birthday, on holiday, on that day)
- **Time** (on the weekend, on time, on a cold day)

- **Hours** (At 7 am, at 12 o'clock, at 5 pm)
- **Holidays without "day"** (At Easter, at Christmas, at New year)
- **Parts of a day** (at night, at lunch, at dinner time)
- **Time** (at present, at breakfast, at that time)

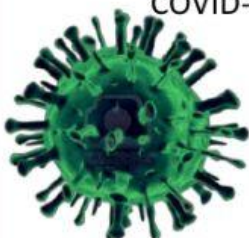
