 - a. A strategy to gradually reduce support as learners gain independence.
2. Scaffolding
 - b. A focus on language for learning, not just about language.
3. Language of learning
 - c. A core model including Content, Communication, Cognition, and Culture.
4. Learner autonomy
 - d. When students take responsibility for their learning.
5. Task-based learning
 - e. A method that emphasizes completing meaningful tasks using language.
6. CLIL teacher
 - f. A learner who develops language skills through subject content.
7. Language expert
 - g. Focuses on language structures and vocabulary.
8. Subject teacher
 - h. A teacher who integrates both content and language objectives.
9. CLIL learner
 - i. Provides content knowledge and context in a second language.
10. Peer learning
 - j. Learning supported by classmates through group or pair work.
