Possessive Pronouns	mine, yours, his, hers, its, ours, theirs	Used after verb to be to show ownership  This book is mine.
		can function as <b>subjects</b> . (The possession needs to be known by both the speaker and listener)  <i>This pen is mine.</i> (subject complement) <i>Yours is on the table.</i> (subject)
