P I took two this morning.

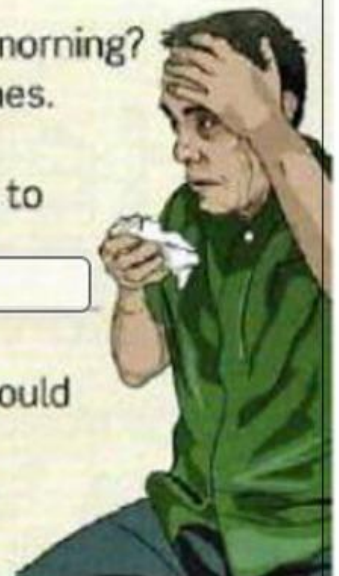
D And have you taken your temperature this morning?
