## PHRASAL VERBS WITH



**Make over** – to completely transform, especially a person's appearance.

*Example:* They decided to **make over** the old apartment, giving it a fresh coat of paint and modern furnishings.

**Make into** – to change something into something else.

*Example:* She took the old curtains and **made them into** a beautiful scarf.

**Make up for** – to compensate for something.

*Example:* He worked extra hours over the weekend to **make up for** the time he missed during the week.

**Make it up to** – to compensate for having done something wrong.

*Example:* I'm sorry for being late; I promise I'll **make it up to** you tomorrow.

**Make it through** – to survive or successfully complete something difficult.

*Example:* She was exhausted, but she **made it through** the marathon.

**Make up** – to invent or fabricate a story, excuse, or plan.

*Example:* She decided to **make up** an excuse for being late to the meeting.

**Make do with** – to accept something less satisfactory because there is no better alternative.

*Example:* We didn't have enough chairs, so we had to **make do with** a few cushions on the floor.

**Make it** – to become very successful or survive a difficult situation.

*Example:* I wasn't sure I'd **make it** to the airport on time because of the traffic, but I did.

**Make of** – to understand something or have an opinion about it.

*Example:* I don't know what to **make of** his strange behavior at the party last weekend.
