As coronavirus continues to spread at an **alarming** rate, employees might be asked to work from home. Schools have already been forced to close over the virus and it has been suggested that employers apply the same strategies to protect their workforce. So what can you do to stay productive if you suddenly have to work from your own house?

To begin with, be prepared and don't just wait until you're told to stay home. Find every computer or laptop software you need in order to maintain your productivity. Save any important sources and links on the Internet, phone numbers and other essential information. Additionally, managers should make sure that employees have the necessary tools to continue working from home and try to **keep track of** their progress on a regular basis.

Another thing you need to do is to set up a personal workspace at home. For some, a home office might mean an entire room while for others, it can just be a kitchen table. Technically, you can choose anywhere with a flat surface and where the internet can work, but try and make it as distraction-free as possible.

Finally, be prepared for remote meetings. **Before the meeting, everyone should have an agenda so that they know what will be discussed.** Managers must also make sure that everyone has a chance to speak and contribute ideas during the meeting by telling them things like: “I will start on this issue, and then I want Alex to talk about that issue, and after that it will be Mary’s turn to speak...” at the start of the meeting. This will also make sure that people will not interrupt each other, especially in meetings with more than 5 participants.

[I] In the digital age, social media platforms have become an integral part of daily life, not only for younger generations but also for adults. While social media allows individuals to stay connected, access information, and even find career opportunities, it also comes with a range of social, emotional, and psychological implications. As the use of these platforms has increased among adults, their effects on personal well-being and social interactions have sparked considerable debate.

[II] Many adults are increasingly turning to social media to maintain relationships, stay informed about current events, and engage with communities that share similar interests. However, the impact of social media on personal relationships can be mixed. On one hand, platforms provide opportunities for reconnecting with long-lost friends and family members, but on the other hand, they may lead to **superficial** interactions, as users often prioritize virtual connections over face-to-face communication. Additionally, excessive use of social media has been associated with sleep disturbances, as adults find themselves scrolling through their feeds late into the night, further exacerbating mental health challenges.

[IV] Despite these negative aspects, social media also holds potential for positive change. For adults, it can serve as a platform for personal growth, professional networking, and engagement with advocacy movements. Furthermore, it can provide adults with a sense of belonging in an increasingly disconnected world. **By being mindful of their usage patterns and prioritizing meaningful interactions, adults can mitigate the risks while enjoying the benefits of social media.** As social media continues to evolve, it remains crucial to strike a balance between its positive and negative effects on individuals' lives.
