



Greetings and Basic Introductions.

Objective: Students will demonstrate their speaking skills by reproducing basic English greetings and introductory phrases they hear, imitating them correctly, and demonstrating attention to pronunciation and intonation.

Instructions:

Listen and Record Each Phrase:

- You will see a list of English phrases below. Next to each phrase, you will find an audio button (it looks like a speaker).
- Click the audio button for each phrase to listen carefully to the teacher saying it.
- After you listen, you will see a microphone icon next to the phrase. Click this microphone icon to start **recording** your voice.
- **Repeat** the phrase you just heard as best as you can. Try to make your voice sound like the teacher's.

Pay Special Attention:

- When you repeat, try to make your words sound clear (this is called pronunciation).
- Also, try to make your voice go up and down correctly (this is called intonation) for questions or statements.
