We use <i>GO</i> with a sporting activity, ending in <i>-ing</i>	We use <i>DO</i> with a sporting activity, often an exercise activity, not ending in <i>-ing</i> <i>Note that there are some exceptions to these rules. For example: DO BOXING</i>	We use <i>PLAY</i> with a game uses a ball, often it teams
