

Paris Cracks Down on Electric Scooter Misuse

The trend of [redacted] and riding two-wheel scooters has taken off in Paris, causing city officials to impose fines for misuse. Electric [redacted] users in Paris can be fined for parking in doorways, riding over 20 km/hour, and riding on the [redacted]. In addition, rental operators will soon have to pay a fee for each scooter that is in their fleet. There are [redacted] at least 20,000 scooters available in Paris, a number that is expected to double by the end of this year.
