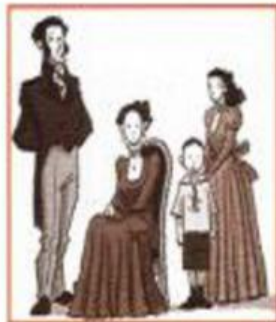

Animals in Danger

A long time ago, huge animals like dinosaurs lived on Earth. But now, they are extinct. This means they are gone forever. We know about them because of fossils—the hard bones found in the ground.

But dinosaurs aren't the only animals that disappeared. Other animals like the dodo bird and the woolly mammoth are also extinct. They disappeared because of hunting, climate change, or losing their homes.

Today, many animals are still alive but are in trouble. These animals are called endangered animals. They might disappear soon if we don't help. For example, tigers, pandas, and rhinos are all endangered. There are only a few of them left in the world!

Why are they in danger?

Because people are cutting down trees, building cities, and hunting animals. When animals lose their homes or can't find food, they can't survive.

But we can help! People are building wildlife parks, planting trees, and teaching others to protect animals. If we work together, we can save them from becoming extinct.
