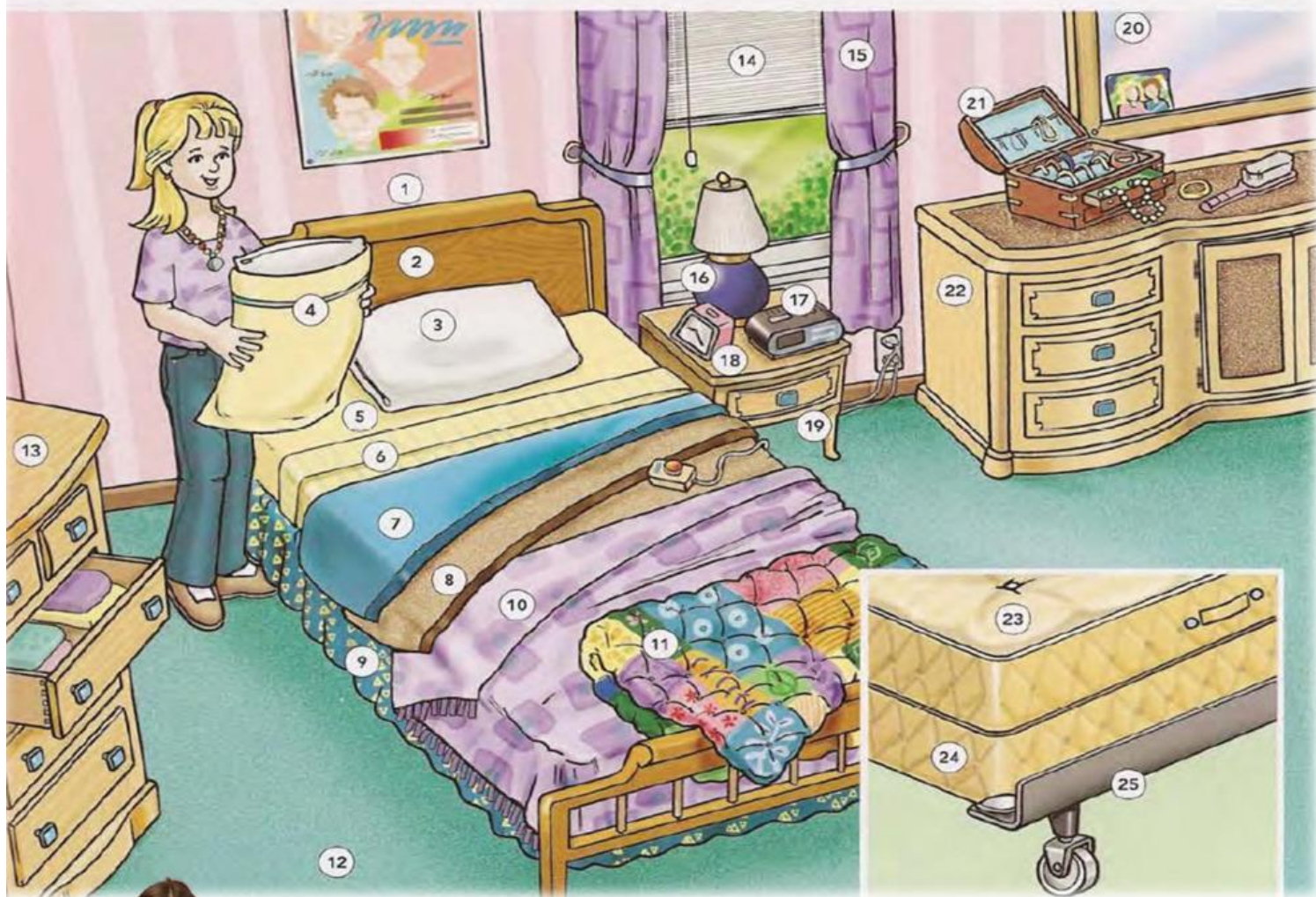

Ana: Haha, don't worry. At least **there is** a nice **bathtub** if you want to relax.
