IMPERATIVES

An **imperative** is a sentence that gives a **command**, **instruction**, **advice**, or **request**. It usually **starts with a verb** and does **not have a subject** because the subject is **understood to be "you"**.

GRAMMAR CHART:

Form	Example
Base verb	"Stand up!"
Negative form	"Don't talk!"
Polite form	"Please close the door."

USES OF IMPERATIVES:

Use	Example
Orders / Commands	"March!" / "Stop!"
Instructions	"Open your books."
Warnings	"Don't run!"
Requests (polite)	"Please pass the flag."

SPELLING RULES:

Imperatives use the base form of the verb:	For negative imperatives, use:
✓ Clean your boots.	✓ Don't + base verb
No subject (You) is needed.	X Don't cleaning...
