

IN INDONESIA, PEOPLE WEAR BATIK ON SPECIAL DAYS, LIKE WEDDINGS OR INDEPENDENCE DAY. BATIK IS ALSO A GIFT FOR IMPORTANT GUESTS, LIKE PRESIDENTS OR VISITORS FROM OTHER COUNTRIES. IN 2009, UNESCO SAID THAT BATIK IS A WORLD CULTURAL HERITAGE. THIS MEANS BATIK IS SPECIAL FOR THE WHOLE WORLD, NOT ONLY FOR INDONESIA.


