SINGULAR

I	am not	sad.
You	aren't	at home.
He	isn't	thirsty.
She	isn't	a pilot.
It	isn't	small.

PLURAL

We	aren't	late.
You	aren't	teachers.
They	aren't	noisy.

QUESTIONS

+ Affirmative: They **are** happy.

? Question: **Are** they happy ?

Short Answer: Yes, they are / No, they aren't

She **is** rich.

? Question: **Is** she rich ?

Short Answer: Yes, she is / No, she isn't

CONTRACTIONS
