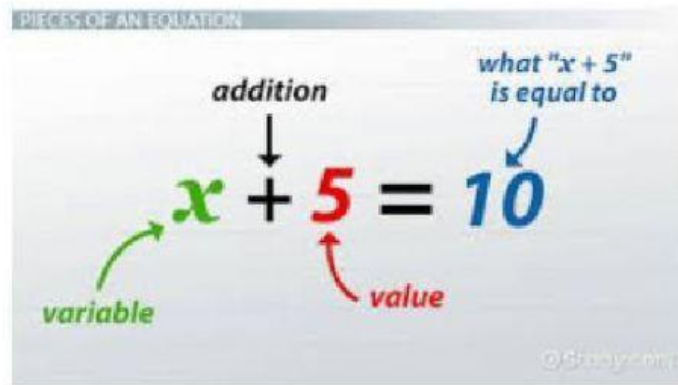


Equations with One Variable



Remember: An equation with one variable must have two things

- An equal sign AND
- a letter to take the place of an unknown number.

Directions: Circle the number sentence in each row that is an equation with one variable.

1. $4 + x = 9$

$3 + 4$

$2 + 1 = 3$

2. $6 + 1$

$5 + x = 7$

$5 + 5 = 10$

3. $x + 8 = 12$

$4 + 2 = 6$

$7 + 2 = 9$

4. $2 + 9 = 11$

$x + 3 = 7$

$5 + 7$

5. $6 + x = 8$

$2 + 9$

$4 + 7 = 11$
