V1: buy - V2: bought - V3: bought

Passive: Fruit \_\_\_\_\_ at the supermarket.

7. Active: The pilot flies the plane.

V1: fly - V2: flew - V3: flown

Passive: The plane \_\_\_\_\_ by the pilot.
