Literal Meaning

Introducir el pie en un lugar, como si te tropezaras o te equivocaras físicamente.

Figurative Meaning

Cometer un error o decir algo inapropiado, causando una situación incómoda

To put one's foot in it



To place your foot somewhere, like stepping into something by mistake.



Making a mistake or saying something inappropriate, causing an uncomfortable situation
