

Infinitives to-infinitives

Dad : I'm home! What did everyone do today?

Mum: I bought some peaches **to make** a cake.

Alex : I used some leaves and stickers **to make** a card.

Pam: I went to the shopping mall.

Dad : Why did you go to the shopping mall?

Pam: I went there **to buy** a present for you. Happy Birthday!



We can use **to + infinitive (base form)** to show the purpose of an action.

Why did you buy coloured paper?

To wrap the presents.

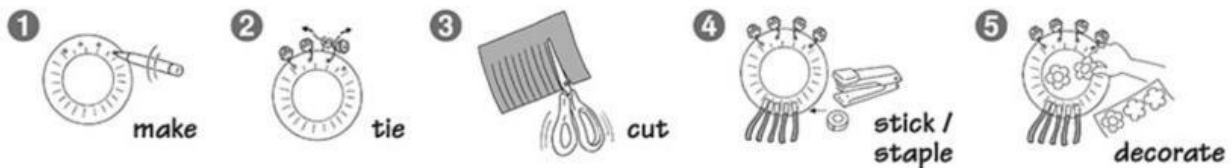
