Ferdinand Cheval was born in 1836. He worked as a postman but is best known as the builder of an unusual palace called the Le Palais Ideal, which is situated in Hauterives - a small town 30 miles south of Lyon in France. The story says that one day, when he was walking along his mail route, he stumbled and nearly fell over. Apparently, the shape of the stone that he had tripped on was so amazing that it inspired him to build the imaginative palace.



Completing such a task is not so easy if you are not an architect or even a builder but it did not seem to be a problem for Cheval. Having a clear target and being a very hardworking man, every day he was learning more about how to build, after with he began working long hours on the actual construction of the castle. Walking along his 42 kilometre-long mail route, he would collect stones, which he used to build the palace. After thirty -three years, the building was finally completed and those people who had at first criticised him, started to admire the results of his work. This original castle of grottoes was created in many different architectural styles, taken from many different cultures. The postman wanted to be buried in his creation but, as it would have been against the French law, he was buried instead in the mausoleum in Hauterives cementary in 1924.

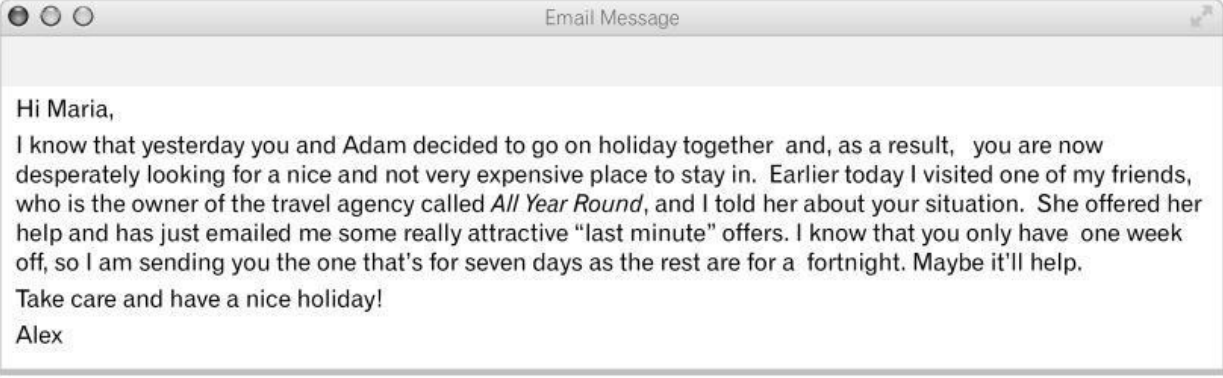

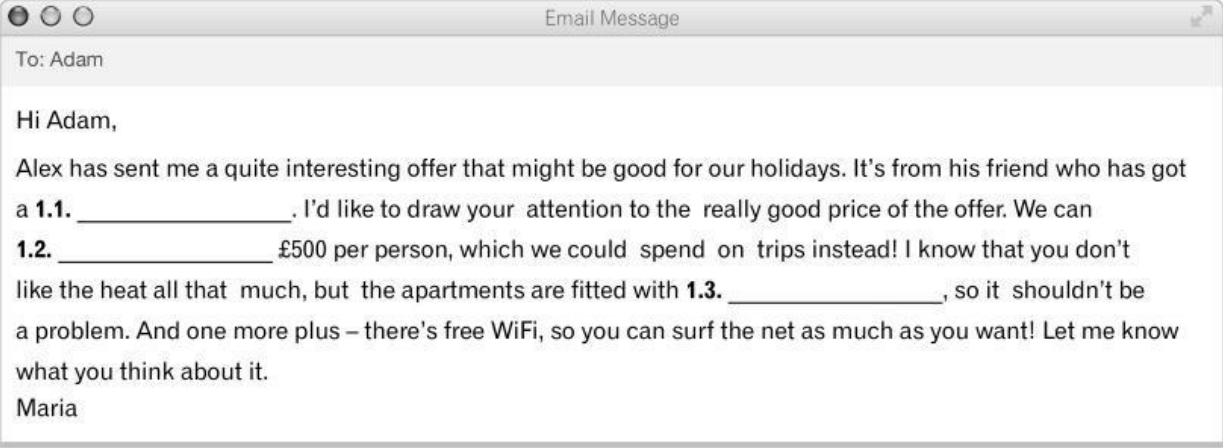
