- ★ *In my dream, I **baked** a rainbow cake.*

We use **The Past Simple Tense** to talk about the main actions in your dream.

- ★ *I **was baking** a rainbow cake when the alarm **rang**.*

We use **The Past Continuous Tense** to show actions that were in progress when another action happened.
