❖ **Mẹo 1: Gạch dưới từ khóa (Underline keywords)**

Khi đọc câu hỏi, con hãy **gạch dưới những từ quan trọng** như: tên người, nơi chốn, thời gian, hoặc động từ chính. Những từ này sẽ giúp con **tập trung tìm đúng thông tin** trong bài đọc.

❖ **Ví dụ:**

Câu hỏi: *Do not lean out of the train window or open the door while the train is moving.*

❖ **Mẹo 2: Đọc lướt và đọc quét (Skim and Scan)**

- **Skim (Đọc lướt):** Con hãy lướt nhanh cả đoạn để **hiểu ý chính** của bài, không cần đọc kỹ từng từ.
- **Scan (Đọc quét):** Sau đó, con hãy **tìm thông tin cụ thể** bằng cách quét mắt nhanh qua bài để tìm từ khóa đã gạch dưới.

❖ **Ví dụ:**

Câu hỏi: *Smoking is only allowed in the smoking areas.*

→ Con đọc lướt để biết bài nói về việc chỉ được hút thuốc trong khu vực cho phép

→ Sau đó, con scan để tìm từ như *Smoking, only allowed, smoking areas,...*

❖ **Mẹo 3: Nhận biết từ đồng nghĩa (Spot synonyms)**

Đôi khi, từ trong bài đọc không giống y hệt từ trong câu hỏi, mà được viết bằng từ **đồng nghĩa hoặc diễn đạt khác**. Con cần học cách nhận ra các từ gần nghĩa để **không bị lạc hướng**.

❖ **Ví dụ:**

Câu hỏi: *What time does the film start?*

→ Trong bài, có thể không dùng từ *start*, mà là *begin* hoặc *starts at 6 p.m.*

Từ **đồng nghĩa cần chú ý**:


- *lean out = stick your head/body out*
- *smoking areas = places for smoking*
- *go off = switch off*
- *prices reduced = discounts, special offer*


