Write your essay using all notes and give reasons for your point of view.

Write about:

- 1 learning from a teacher
- 2 learning from experience
- 3 ..... (your own idea).

- Paragraph 1: Introduce the subject: e.g. *Some people believe....* Give your opinion e.g. *Personally, I believe...* . Suggest the other ways of learning that you will talk about.
- Paragraphs 2, 3 and 4: Give your opinion, (e.g. *I think / believe*) about the advantages and disadvantages of learning from a teacher/experience/your own idea, e.g. *One of the main (dis)advantages/benefits...; another (dis)advantage...* .
- Paragraph 5: Conclude with a summary of your opinion, e.g. In conclusion...
