

# PRESENT CONTINUOUS

We use the Present Continuous Tense when talking about things that are happening right now or around the current time.

POSITIVE	NEGATIVE	QUESTION
I am eating.	I am not eating.	Am I eating?
You are eating.	You aren't eating.	Are you eating?
We are eating.	We aren't eating.	Are we eating?
They are eating.	They aren't eating.	Are they eating?
He is eating.	He isn't eating.	Is he eating?
She is eating.	She isn't eating.	Is she eating?
It is eating.	It isn't eating.	Is it eating?
