Grammar Focus: Past Simple vs Past Continuous

Past Simple: finished actions in the past

Examples:

- I lost my phone.
- He found it.

Past Continuous: actions in progress in the past (background)

Examples:

- I was walking to the station.
- He was running down the street.

Common structure: was/were + verb-ing

Together:

- I lost my phone **while I was walking**.
 - **While we were talking**, someone almost stepped on the bag.
