My name is David and I live in London. I want to tell you about my daily routine and how I get around this amazing city.

I wake up at 6:45 AM every weekday. After I brush my teeth and have breakfast, I leave my house at 7:30 AM. I live in Zone 3, so I need to travel to the city center for work.

First, I walk to the bus stop near my house. It's opposite the small park and next to the post office. I take the number 25 bus to the tube station. The bus journey takes about 15 minutes. Sometimes there are traffic jams, especially during rush hour.

At the tube station, I catch the Central Line to Oxford Street. I love traveling by Underground because it's fast and reliable. The train journey takes 20 minutes, and I usually read my book or listen to music.

On weekends, my routine is different. I often cycle around London using the city's bike-sharing system. There are bike lanes on many streets, and it's a great way to see the city and get exercise.
