Multiplicar:

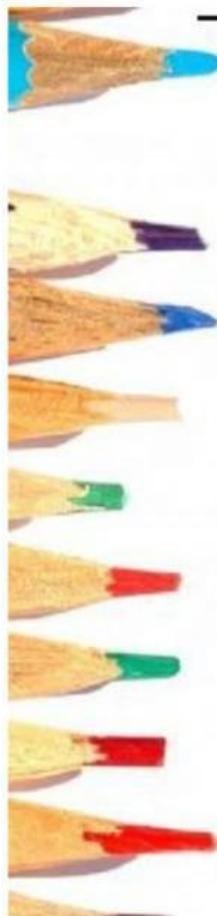
$$\frac{2}{5} \times \frac{4}{6} \times \frac{5}{8} = \frac{2 \times 4 \times 5}{5 \times 6 \times 8} = \frac{40}{240} = \frac{1}{6}$$

Simplificando antes de multiplicar:

$$\frac{\cancel{2}^1}{\cancel{5}_1} \times \frac{\cancel{4}^2}{\cancel{6}_2} \times \frac{\cancel{5}^1}{\cancel{8}_4} = \frac{1 \times 1 \times 1}{1 \times 6 \times 1} = \frac{1}{6}$$

$$\frac{\cancel{2}^1}{\cancel{10}_2} \times \frac{\cancel{2}^1}{\cancel{15}_3} = \frac{4}{9}$$

$$\frac{\cancel{5}^1}{\cancel{25}_5} \times \frac{\cancel{12}^4}{\cancel{24}_3} = \frac{20}{21}$$
