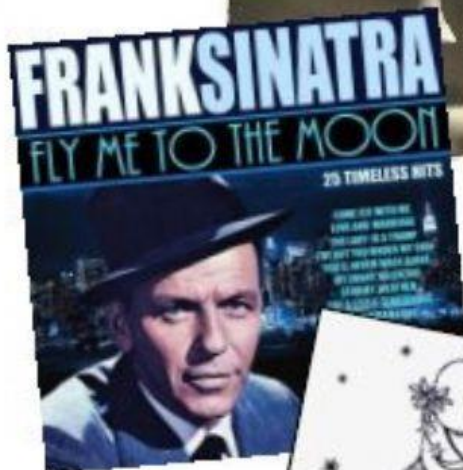

This song was written <sup>1</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ 1954 and Felicia Sanders sang it for the first time. It <sup>2</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ to have a different name, which was 'In Other Words'. It became popular under the name 'Fly me to the Moon' <sup>3</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ editors eventually changed its name. It has been a jazz standard ever <sup>4</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ it was released.
