

Higher Understanding Music – Practise Questions

Question 8F

You will hear an excerpt from a piece of vocal music.

Below is a list of features that occur in the music.

There will now be a pause of 1 minute to allow you to read through the question.

The lyrics of the song are printed in the table on the opposite page. You should insert each feature once in the column on the right, at the point where it occurs.

You only need to **insert the underlined word**.

- First entry of Muted trumpets
- Ascending Scale played by the woodwind
- Repetition in the woodwind section
- Descending Chromatic scale played by the violins
- A Cymbal Roll is heard

The music will now be played **three times** with a pause of 20 seconds between playings and a pause of 30 seconds at the end.
