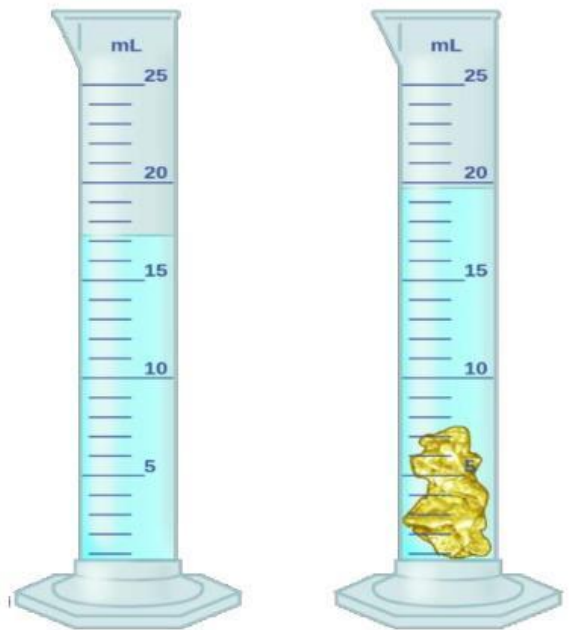
2. You are provided with a small nugget of an unknown substance.
